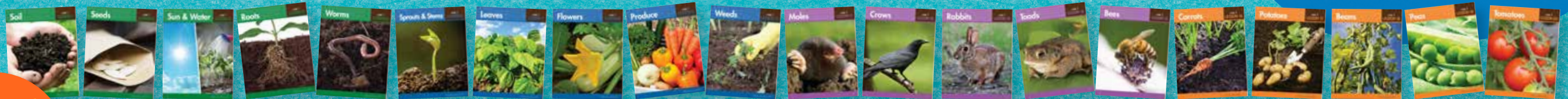

Circle Time

Greeting Song
Weather

Discussion

- Show the Seedling Poster and invite children to share what they see. Give each child a bean seed to hold and ask, "What do you think this seed needs to grow?" Write or draw the children's ideas.
- Encourage children to squat like a tiny seed and then stand up with arms stretched out.



COMMUNITY CHALLENGE

Harvest the Garden

SUPPLIES
□ Garden Photos

Do Together

- Place the garden photos face down on the ground in a circle.
- While reciting the poem, children walk around the photos.
- At the end of the rhyme, name a child to turn over the card closest to him and encourage him to identify the vegetable.
- Recite the rhyme again and repeat until each child has a turn.

Deep underground
Is a seed small and round.

This activity encourages children to cooperate in a group, be patient and wait their turn.

My Greenhouse

SUPPLIES

□ Greenhouse
□ Seed Journal
□ Bag
□ Beans
□ Cotton balls
□ Crayons

Discuss

- How many days do you think it will take for a bean to grow? Encourage children to share their predictions. Record their ideas.

Make

- Lightly wet the cotton balls.
- Invite children to put the cotton ball and seed in the clear zip bag.
- Color and decorate the greenhouse.

Play

- Encourage the child to hunt for somewhere sunny to hang the greenhouse.
- Check on the seed daily.
- When the child sees a change, encourage him to draw it on the seed journal.

OBSERVE: Did the child observe and describe the changes either with words or by drawing? How did you notice the child's interest in the bean increase or decrease each day?

SMALL GROUP MATH

Garden Colors

PATTERNS AND SORTING 18.2 SOCIALIZATION 31.2

SUPPLIES
□ Folder Game
□ Game Pieces
and Cube

Discuss

- What colors might you find in a garden? Encourage children to roll the cube and hunt for something in the room that is the same color.

Play Together

- Invite a child to roll the cube and move his game piece to the next vegetable that matches his color.
- Continue taking turns until all children have reached the garden.
- Simplify:** Point at the cube, name the color and invite the child to find the matching color anywhere on the game board. Clap and repeat.
- Challenge:** Invite the child to predict which color he thinks he will roll. Roll the cube and keep track of how many times the child guessed the correct color.

OBSERVE: Did the child match the color on the cube to the vegetable? Did he play cooperatively with others and take turns?

SUGGESTED STORY

READING COMPREHENSION 13.2 MEASUREMENT 19.1

- Ask, "What is the tallest thing you have seen?" Set out blocks and encourage children to stack and count.
- Encourage children to work together to build a tower as tall as possible, then count.
- Read the story aloud and hold up the Storytelling Pieces.
- After reading, ask questions and share ideas about what might happen next.
- Work together to retell the story with the blocks and storytelling pieces.

- If you were a seed, which type of seed would you want to be? Why?

Plant a Bean

DANCE AND MOVEMENT 31.1 GROSS MOTOR 4.2

- Sing the lyrics below to the tune of "Do Your Ears Hang Low?" and dance with the suggested movements. Begin slowly and sing more quickly each time you repeat.

Can you plant a bean,
Watch it grow up big
and green?
(Open and shut hands.)

Can you water the seed,
And pull out the weeds?
(Squat down and stand up as you slap hands on thighs, then reach up high.)

Can you shine like the sun,
And pick pods one by one?
(Rock side-to-side with arms above head like a sun.)

Working is done,
now let's eat that bean.
(March in place.)

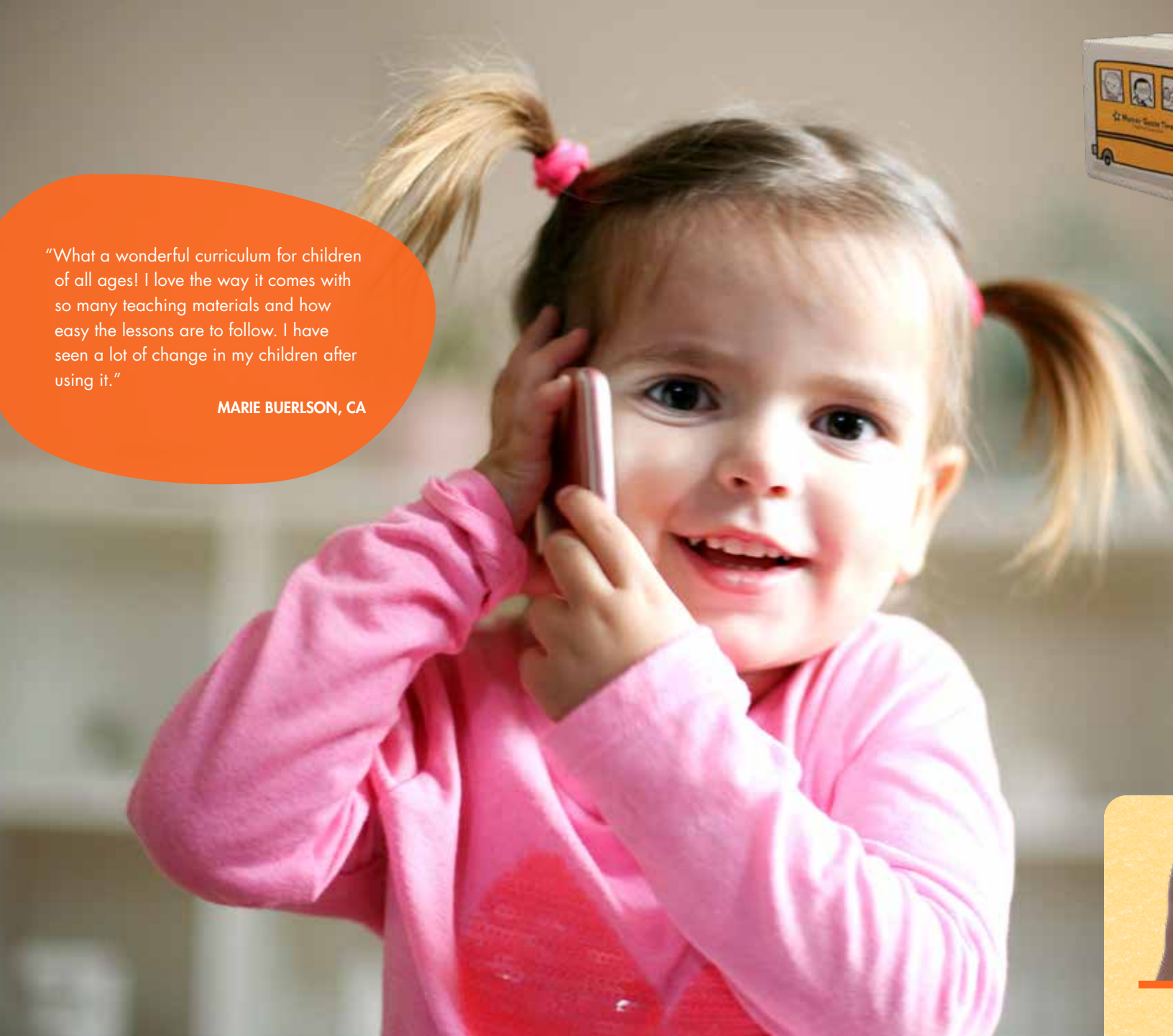
