Discuss & Explore

- · What toys do you play with in the tub?
- · Set out a bin of water, an empty container and bath toys. Invite children to squirt water into the empty container.

Play Together

- · Give each child an I Can Read book.
- · Invite children to point to the text as vou read aloud
- · Encourage children to underline any word that ends in -ub.
- · Simplify: Invite the child to help turn the pages and you read the text.
- · Challenge: You read the text then invite the child to read the same text.

OBSERVE: Does the child turn the pages and follow along with the reading? Does she find a word that ends in -ub?


